1. About INVA trust

Indian Navy Veteran Artificer Trust is a registered charitable trust created by veteran artificers for veteran artificers. It was registered on 13 May 2020 under the trust act.

2. Objective of Trust

- a. To reach out to veterans who are economically and socially disadvantaged.
- b. To assist the deserving children of demised veterans with education fees, books, uniforms, school bags and scholarships to augment their education activity.
- c. To provide financial support for health and welfare of dependents of the sponsored Artificers.
- d. To organize various activities to enroll willing and capable sponsors for fundraising to increase the reach-out and enhance the effectiveness of INVA Trust.

3. Vison & Mission of the Trust

While most of the veteran artificers, after leaving the Indian Navy, are doing exceptionally well, some are in bad shape physically as well as financially, due to several reasons like - illness, terminal disease or inadequate income, have lost their savings and earnings in their family welfare while their children are not yet settled as they were attending to school / college, loss of spouse, social isolation etc. Some veteran artificers have retired from the Indian Navy without any pension or little pension.

The main aim and vision of this INVA Trust is to support with one-time financial help to the distressed Veteran Artificers to overcome their and their families' Medical / Hospital / Surgical and after Surgery Expenses or to meet their Children's Education Expenses or the very Survival, since they have fallen to such situations that they are unable to sustain/help themselves and live a dignified life.

It is also envisaged that a situation might arise, wherein, a Veteran Artificer could be in need of immediate Medical attention and thus on the spot financial help. In such a case, the INVA Trust will immediately make a suitable financial payment, directly to the concerned hospital, pending normal formalities as required by the Trust By-Laws. The final payment if required, shall be attended to in due course.

4. The Board of Trustees

1. INVA Trust is managed through a Board of Trustees (BOT) comprising of Founding Trustees and Co-opted Trustees. Founding Trustees are the Permanent members.
2. The minimum number of trustees shall be three (3) and the maximum to be eight (8).
3. A Co-opted Trustee member will serve for a term of 3 (three) years and may serve for more than one term and if so, resolved by a Two-third majority at the end of each term
4. CHAIRMAN – Presides the BOT and represents INVA trust. The tenure of the Chairman shall be 3 (three) years and may be extended by the BOT.
5. The Managing Trustee to be elected by BOT for 3 years for all day-to-day operations.
6. BOT shall govern the affairs of TRUST and be responsible for funds of the Trust.
7. BOT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PRINCIPLE and must upkeep and protect the Trust Deed.
8. BOT may delegate all or any functions to the Governing Body (GB) as permissible by the Byelaws authorized by the Trust Deed.
9. BOT will not formulate OPERATIONAL POLICIES, which is the sole responsibility of GB. However, BOT has to approve all Policies made by GB to make them effective....

5. Governing Body

1. BOT empowers GB to execute the policy of INVA Trust as per the Mission Plan.
2. GB must lead, create OPERATIONAL POLICIES to carry out the Mission of Trust.
3. To plan and set overall functional direction, purpose, goals, ethics, and values.
4. To interact with BOT; steer relationships, alliances, and collaborations with the Doners, Members, Public and with Stakeholders.
5. To control and ensure the INVA trust is accountable, legal, and financially stable; hire functional managers and supervise them; monitor overall outcomes.
6. GB member tenure is for 3 years. Each year one third (1/3) of total Members will retire and new members will be elected.
7. The Governing Body shall consist of not less than 6 (six) members and will not exceed 16 (sixteen) members. It may be amended by BOT
8. To add a member, GB may nominate new member names to BOT for their approval. BOT may approve or reject and will install the new member of GB.
9. GB may create INVA TASK Force and empower them to formulate PROCEEDURAL STEPS to execute Operational Policies.

3. To interact with Partner In Distress (PID), organize survey, assess quanta of help and report to GB.
4. To campaign and nominate regional Ambassadors, operate e-mail, update social media and carry out all tasks assigned to them by GB or BOT.

7. INVA Ambassadors

1. Volunteer Partners are taken onboard to make Trust service available regionally.
2. To front-end a 'Partner in Distress', visit, survey the need of PID and render the moral support as well as disseminate help and fund.
3. To represent the INVA Trust Locally and help in Fund Raising, organize functions.
4. To encourage volunteering and work with Task Force, GB to promote INVA Trust.

9. PROCESS FOR ATTENDING TO THE PERSON IN DISTRESS (PID)

The Ambassadors will be contacted first by the Person In Distress (PID) in that region or nearby, or shall be informed by the Governing Body, if they receive a distress call directly to them. This Ambassador or his trusted assistant shall visit the Person In Distress (PID)/ Family to assess the situation and collect the details of the case as per the norms set by the Governing Body. He shall then contact the Secretary of the GB with his report and recommendations. Within 24 hours of the report from the Ambassador, the GB shall scrutinise the validity of the case and send its recommendation for further action and payment, to the INVA Trust. The Trustees, in turn, shall deliberate and decide the amount disbursed through the Ambassador as per the By-laws of the Trust and ensure that the distressed Veteran Partner/Family (PID) receives the help in time.

10. Activity

10a. Financial Assistance to Person in Distress (PID)

DONORS OF INVA TRUST EXTENDS HELPING HAND TO INDIAN NAVY VETERAN ARTIFICERS THEIR FAMILIES IN DISTRESS

PID # 5

INVA TRUST came to know sudden demise of one of their veteran Partner Kamlesh (name changed for privacy of the family). The Trust was informed by their volunteers called "Ambassadors and Task force" who visited the Distressed family of the PID to witness and study prevailing conditions of the family at their living place and made recommendations to the GOVERNING BODY OF THE TRUST for financial help to mitigate their woes.

Mr Kamlesh is survived by his wife, a daughter and son. The wife of the deceased veteran was involved in a serious accident & injured physically and undergoing prolonged medical treatment for the past four years.

PID's daughter had done B. Tech but not employed and son was doing BBA.

The family survives only by the pension of the PID. They had their own home for living. They neither had any savings nor any other source of income.

However, they were not able to live a simple and dignified life due to financial burden caused by the medical bills of the mother and education fee of the son.

The BOT sanctioned an amount of INR 300 K to the distressed family to tide over their immediate needs to cover medical expenses and tuition fees.

PID # 6.

THIS IS THE PID CASE OF PARTNER SURESH KUMAR (NAME CHANGED) FROM KERALA.

Partner Suresh retired from Navy in 2000.

During the pandemic partner lost his job of instructor in one of the private institutes. He was job less and trying to sustain himself and his family. He had taken a bank loan of Rs. 18 lakhs against mortgage of his only house. He also took gold and personal loans amounting to Rs. 5 lakhs.

In 2022 he suffered severe Cardiac arrest and expired on February 22, 2022. He was survived by his wife and a son. His son has done LLB and looking for a job. The family had no source of income other than the family pension which is still under process. The family has a huge burden of servicing the outstanding loans.

The class mates and other partners living in that area of late Partner Suresh have contributed Rs. 2 lakhs.

4. The INVA TRUST sanctioned Rs. 5 lakhs on the recommendations of GB who were advised by the Ambassadors and the Task force who studied and verified the application request from the family of the deceased PID.

PID # 7.

THIS IS THE CASE OF A VETERAN SWAMY (NAME CHANGED) FROM CHENNAI.

Mr Swamy retired from Navy in 1978. He is suffering from cancer which was detected in 2021. He is under constant medical care and requires expensive treatments on regular intervals in the Hospital. He did not have ECHS card since he did not have requisite documents required to apply for the same.

The PID lives in BANGALORE with his elder daughter who is married and has her own family of two children. She is taking care of him and takes care of his medical expenses which is a big challenge for her.

PID is receiving his monthly pension. He has a house in Chennai. He has no other income from any other source. He is not fit to travel under prevailing medical conditions.

PID had received Rs. 50K from Bangalore Artificers association. His daughter is managing his medical expenses from her salary and fund raising through IMPACT a fund raising platform. She also had to look after one of her children who is specially challenged.

The GB of INVA TRUST recommended Rs. 3 Lakhs for the partners wellbeing and medical expenses.

PID # 8

THIS IS THE CASE OF PARTNER SACHIN KAMKAR (NAME CHANGED) FROM MUMBAI.

Mr Sachin left Navy without pensionable service. He is suffering from acute Kidney problem and needs regular dialyses 3 times a week. He is suffering from other medical conditions too including speech related and heart problem. He has been treated for the angioplasty with stents.

PID was running his private business after leaving the Navy. His business did not flourish due to lockdown. His business partners are taking care of him in small amounts of medical care. However, he needs approximately Rs. 50 -55000/pm to meet his medical expenses.

4. The INVA TRUST helped his family with a grant of Rs. 6 lakhs to take care of his medical expenses for one year.

PID # 9

THIS CASE OF THIS PID WAS HIGHLIGHTED DURING ONE OF THE THE EXAM FORUMS.

Mr Suresh (name changed due to privacy of the family) had retired in 1992 and was running his business at Ludhiana city. He ran into debt and also met with a serious accident which resulted in a permanent disability.

He eventually died in 2012 due to his medical conditions.

He is survived by his wife aged 65 years, son aged 39 and two daughters aged 35 & 25.

His son works in a private job with a salary of approx 10-15 thousand only

Partners' elder daughter was married but separated now and living with mother.

The younger daughter is suffering from Asthama for the past many years. She is doing her under graduate studies. The wife of the PID is getting Rs. 17500/= as family pension which is not sufficient to meet the family's daily needs and other expenses. She is under extreme pressure of financial challenges looking after the whole family including grown up children.

The family is living in an abject poverty and needed immediate help to meet their every basic needs including medical care and studies of the younger daughter. The class mates of the partner had initially contributed approx Rs. 4.5 lakhs which was not sufficient to meet their existing expenses and loans.

The INVA Trust extended financial help of Rs. 6 lakhs to the family to take care of their financial burden and to mitigate their sufferings.

PID # 10

INVA TRUST recently came to know sudden demise of one of their community members Partner VIJAY (name changed for privacy of the family). The Trust was informed by their volunteers called "Ambassadors and Task force" who visited the Distressed family of the partner to witness and study prevailing conditions of the family at their living place and made recommendations to the GOVERNING BODY OF THE TRUST for financial help to mitigate their woes.

Mr Vijay had retired in 2017 passed away in 2022 due to cardiac failure. He is survived by his wife, one daughter aged 18 years who is doing her under graduate degree and one son aged 15 years studying in high school.

The family is living in AGRA in a house purchased by the late partner under bank loan. The PID was employed in a government job on probation (temporary employment). They did not provide any benefits and no other allowances excluding salary.

The family came under financial burden due to various loans taken by the partner to sustain his family and venture into poultry farming in partnership with his brother but this business failed due to his brother cheating on him.

The family of the partner was in distress due to outstanding bank loans and also the education fee of the children. The wife of the PID would be getting pension but not yet processed due to the outstanding loans against the late PID.

The BOT of INVA Trust sanctioned Rs. 6 lakhs to the family on the recommendation of the GB.

This would help them pay for the education fee for both the children for 2 years and family maintenance.

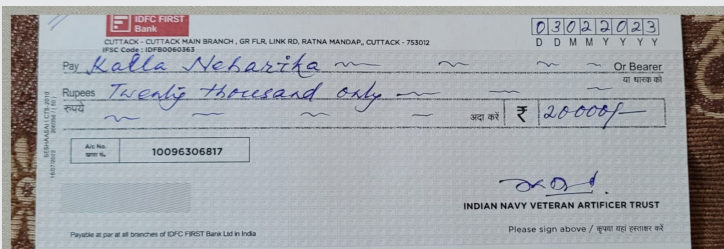
